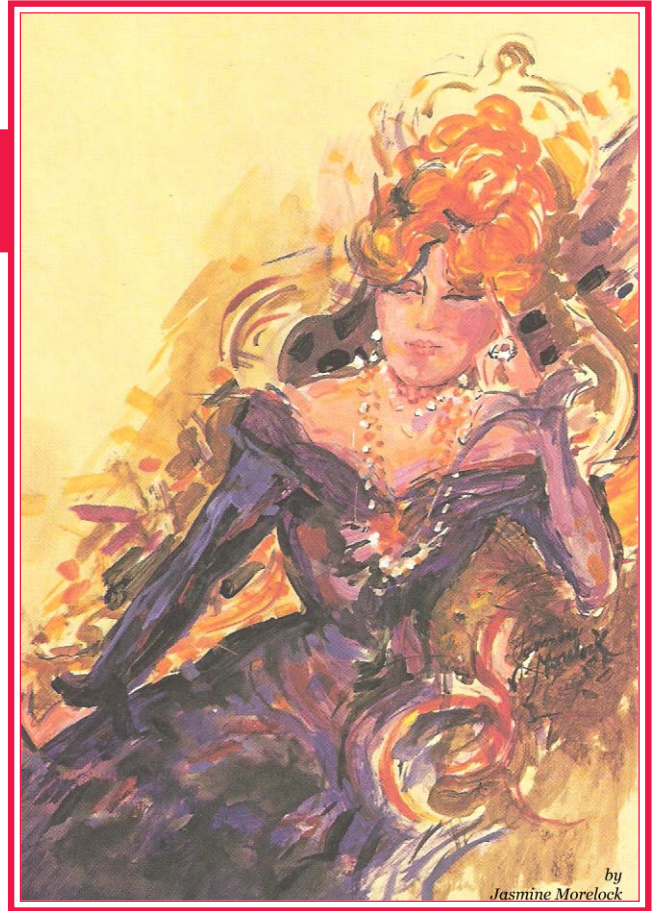
SHREVEPORT MADAM
